


SANDYPALOOZA 2024

More pine cones




Success!

All water stairs were set in place






A very large tree came down in center camp during the winter, thankfully missing the Santos center. By the end of the weekend the tree was cut, split, and moved!

The dining hall cork board was replaced




Santos center, looking good!
