Under the direction of our Associate Executive Director, Mark Straubel, we are focusing our attention towards the aging infrastructure at Sandy Island. Mark is ensuring that the resources Sandy has available are used to the fullest to make the biggest impact for the future success of our beautiful island.

In addition to many smaller projects the big things being done this spring/summer are:

- The flooring at South Lav and Central Lav is being replaced
- 2. The cooking hood in the kitchen will be removed, replaced & expanded
- 3. The kitchen will be getting a new generator
- 4. Stainless steel counter tops are being installed in the kitchen, replacing all areas where there was previously green formica.

Throughout the summer and fall Tighe and Bond Engineering Co. will be coming to Sandy to evaluate two areas. First the tennis courts, the goal being to design a new Tennis court/multi-sport area. The second area they will be looking at is our septic system with the goal of designing upgrades to our current system.

This October Menagerie will be demolished and a foundation for the new cabin laid so that in spring of 2025 the new cabin can be constructed.
